FELIX

The FELIX is a collection of chairs in massive wood designed by Belgian furniture and cabinet maker Frédéric Richard.

The FELIX chair is now available also as a dining chair, following the launch as a lower lounge chair or rocking chair. All 3 versions are available in 2 wood finishes: oak natural oiled or oak tainted black.


The FELIX chair, in its 3 versions, stands out by its minimalistic and elegant design. The designer, being a fine furniture and cabinet maker himself, succeeded in keeping a minimal use of wood for the arm rests of the low and rocking chairs by reinforcing the pieces on the inside with metal parts. This gives the FELIX a delicate elegance in looks while being very sturdy and solid in construction.

The seat is made of a bended plywood shell with oak veneer, in line with the elegance of the legs, which gives the chair a comfortable seating in the 3 versions.

The latest addition to the collection, the dining chair with 4 fixed legs, is stackable for ease of transport or storage.
